

Ohio Northern University Disc Golf Rules

Disc golf is played like ball golf, except a disc is used instead. □
One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score.

Tee throws must be made within the designated tee areas. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the disc golf basket, throws first. Stay clear of other players' throws.

Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the basket on the front edge of the lie where the last throw landed. The other foot may be no closer to the basket than the foot on this lie. A run-up and follow through, after throwing, is normally allowed. Within 10 meters of the basket, a player may not fall forward, even after the disc reaches the basket.

A disc that comes to rest inside or attached to the basket or chains completes the hole. A disc on top of the basket does not count as in.

OUT OF BOUNDS (OB) RULES (one stroke penalty):

ON or OVER any paved parking lot or road (noted with a dotted line of the map)

ON any paved sidewalk (noted with a solid line on the map):

(all of the Green Monster is OB)

ALL discs COMPLETELY SURROUNDED BY WATER

2 METERS (6.5 feet) above the ground (stuck in a tree or bush)

To play a disc that went OB, mark your lie where the disc crossed the OB plane, taking up to a one meter relief, perpendicular from the OB line. A player must always throw from an in-bounds position.

ALL VARSITY SPORTS TEAMS have PRIORITY!

Yield to: Football practice on hole #2, Softball on #7 & #9, Rugby on #8

Please use common courtesies on all other holes, yielding to pedestrians walking on paths.
